CLASS 30—QUILTING

INSTRUCTIONS

- ◆ All articles must be the work of the exhibitor and not previously shown at the Middleville Fair
- ◆ Only new and up-to-date articles will be considered for judging
- ◆ SMA - sample material attached SBA - sample batting attached

HAND QUILTING—Refer to Revised 2019 OAAS Rules & Regulations on separate documents on the WEB site

The “**Best Hand Quilted Quilt of Fair**” will be chosen from Sections 1 and 2. Both are required to be a minimum of 324” measured on the perimeter, and the **complete quilt** must be the work of only **one** individual to qualify. The winning quilt will be awarded a Rosette and Plaque and will be entered in the District O.A.A.S. Competition. The 1st place winner at District Level will then proceed to the OAAS Provincial Level competition. A second place “Best Hand Quilted Quilt of Fair” will also be chosen, winning a Rosette. **If you wish your quilt to be considered for this award it MUST have an entry tag for “Best Hand Quilted Quilt” in addition to the regular Class entry tag.**

Prize money for Sections 1 to 3: 1st—\$20, 2nd—\$15, 3rd—\$10

1. Quilt, pieced, pattern named, min. 72” x 90” or 324” or 810cm measured on the perimeter (SMA, SBA)
2. Quilt, appliquéd, pattern named, min. 72” x 90” 324” or 810cm measured on the perimeter (SMA, SBA)
3. Quilt, pieced or appliquéd, hand-quilted, made by a group or organization (not eligible for OAAS competition) (SMA, SBA)

Prize money: 1st—\$10, 2nd—\$8, 3rd—\$6

4. Quilt, crib or lap—hand-quilted, no panels (SMA, SBA)
5. Hand-quilted wearable article (SMA, SBA)
6. Quilt, hand-quilted, tied—perimeter of 200” or larger (SMA, SBA)

Prize money: 1st—\$8, 2nd—\$6, 3rd—\$4

7. Hand quilted doll’s bed coverlet (SMA, SBA)
8. Scrappy pumpkin patch mini quilt or wall hanging (SMA, SBA)
9. Any small quilted article not listed above. Example table runner, cushion,, tote bag, etc (SMA,SBA)

MACHINE QUILTING—Refer to Revised 2019 OAAS Rules & Regulations on separate documents on the WEB site

The “**Best Machine Quilted Quilt of Fair**” will be chosen from Section 10. Quilt is required to be a minimum of 324” measured on the perimeter, and the **complete quilt** must be the work of only **one** individual to qualify. It must have visible machine quilting. It must not be quilted on a long arm machine. The winning quilt will be awarded a Rosette and will be entered in the District O.A.A.S. Competition. The 1st place winner at District Level will then proceed to the OAAS Provincial Level competition. A second place “Best Machine Quilted Quilt of Fair” will also be chosen, winning a Rosette. **If you wish your quilt to be considered for this award it MUST have an entry tag for “Best Machine Quilted Quilt” in addition to the regular Class entry tag.**

NOTE: Long-arm quilting refers to any type of quilting done on a machine other than a domestic table top or cabinet sewing machine.

Prize money: 1st—\$15, 2nd—\$10, 3rd—\$8

10. Machine-quilted quilt, pattern named, any technique, minimum total perimeter 324".
This is for the OAAS competition (see note above) (SBA, SMA)

Prize money: 1st—\$10, 2nd—\$8, 3rd—\$6

11. Machine-quilted crib or lap quilt, any technique (SMA, SBA)
12. Machine-quilted wearable item (SMA, SBA)
13. Mini quilt or wall hanging —perimeter of 72" or less (SMA, SBA)
14. Any other machine-quilted article not listed above (SMA, SBA)

SPECIAL— QUILTING

15. My First Quilt made by first time quilter. Hand or machine quilted, any size. (SMA, SBA)
16. Barn Quilt Piece crafted by a Registered 4-H Member. Maximum size 2 ft x 2 ft.

INSTRUCTIONS

- All articles must be the work of the exhibitor and **not shown previously** at Middleville Fair
- All articles must be complete and ready for use (unless otherwise specified)
- Only new and up-to-date articles will be considered for judging
- Approximate size means up to 2 inches larger or smaller NOT including fringes or tassels
- **SMA** - sample material attached **SYA** - sample yarn attached

KNITTING

Prize money: 1st—\$10, 2nd—\$8, 3rd—\$5

1. Hand-knit Afghan - min. 36" x 40" (SYA)
2. Hand-knit baby afghan or carriage cover, fine yarn (SYA)
3. Hand-knit child's dress, up to 2 year size (SYA)

Prize money: 1st—\$6, 2nd—\$5, 3rd—\$4

4. Hand-knit socks, any size, on 4 needles (SYA)
5. Hand-knit socks, any size, on 2 needles or circular needles (SYA)
6. Hand-knit mitts, any size (SYA)
7. Hand-knit slippers, any size (SYA)
8. Article using "funky" novelty yarn (SYA)
9. 2 hand-knit dish cloths, different patterns(SYA)
10. Child's hand-knit pullover or cardigan to fit age 6-12 years (SYA)
11. One pair hand knit Boot Toppers, any size (SYA)
12. One pair hand-knit Fingerless Gloves or Mitts (SYA)
13. Any other hand-knit article not listed above, (example Toy, hat, shawl) (SYA)

CROCHETING

Prize money: 1st—\$10, 2nd—\$8, 3rd—\$5

14. Afghan (SYA)
15. Baby afghan or carriage cover, fine yarn (SYA)

Prize money: 1st—\$6, 2nd—\$5, 3rd—\$4

16. A Scarf – Straight or cowl (SYA)

17. Dish cloths— two, different patterns (SYA)
18. Set of 4 Coasters (SYA)
19. A pair of Slippers or Socks (SYA)
20. Set of 2 Placemats (SYA)
21. 2 different small crocheted articles suitable for a bazaar (SYA)
22. Any other crocheted article not listed above (SYA)

SEWING

Prize money: 1st—\$6, 2nd—\$5, 3rd—\$4

23. An Outfit for a Doll- any size- mounted – minimum 2 pieces
24. Set of 4 Placemats and Napkins
25. BBQ apron and 2 Pot Holders
26. A Table Runner
27. A Vest – any size
28. A hand-sewn article (no machine stitching)
29. Any other sewn article not listed above

NEEDLEWORK

- Articles where appropriate, may be mounted on a stretcher frame or in a picture frame

Prize money: 1st—\$6, 2nd—\$5, 3rd—\$4

30. Any cross-stitch article greater than 12"
31. Any cross-stitch article less than 12"
32. Any article featuring hand-embroidery
33. Any article made on plastic canvas
34. Any Latch Hook article (example pillow, rug, wall hanging)
35. A Sampler featuring letters and/or a verse
36. Any woven article
37. Any felted article
38. A festive article of needlework ready to hang (example wall hanging picture)
39. Any other article of needlework not listed above (example Tatting, smocking, bead work, candle wicking, etc)
