### **CLASS 30—QUILTING**

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- ◆ All articles must be the work of the exhibitor and not previously shown at the Middleville Fair
- ◆ Only new and up-to-date articles will be considered for judging
- ◆ **SMA - sample material attached      SBA - sample batting attached**

#### **HAND QUILTING—Refer to 2019 OAAS Rules & Regs beginning on Pg 61.**

The “**Best Hand-Quilted Quilt of Fair**” will be chosen from Sections 1 and 2. Both are required to be a minimum of 324” measured on the perimeter, and the **complete quilt** must be the work of only **one** individual to qualify. The winning quilt will be awarded a Rosette and Plaque and will be entered in the District O.A.A.S. Competition. The 1<sup>st</sup> place winner at District Level will then proceed to the OAAS Provincial Level competition. A 2nd place “Best Hand-Quilted Quilt of Fair” will also be chosen, winning a Rosette. **If you wish your quilt to be considered for this award it MUST have an entry tag for “Best Hand-Quilted Quilt” in addition to the regular Class entry tag.**

**Prize money for Sections 1 to 3: 1st—\$20, 2nd—\$15, 3rd—\$10**

**Best Quilt in Show plaque sponsored by Scott Reid, MP for Lanark, Frontenac, Kingston  
Sections 1 & 2 eligible for OAAS competition—see note above**

1. Quilt, pieced, pattern named, min. 72” x 90” or 324” or 810cm measured on the perimeter (SMA, SBA)
2. Quilt, appliquéd, pattern named, min. 72” x 90” 324” or 810cm measured on the perimeter (SMA, SBA)
3. Quilt, pieced or appliquéd, hand-quilted, made by a group or organization (not eligible for OAAS competition) (SMA, SBA)

**Prize money: 1st—\$10, 2nd—\$8, 3rd—\$6**

4. Quilt, crib or lap—hand-quilted, no panels, min. size 30”x40” (SMA, SBA)
5. Quilt, crib or lap—hand-quilted, made from a purchased a panel or square (SMA, SBA)

**Prize money: 1st—\$8, 2nd—\$6, 3rd—\$4**

6. Hand-quilted tote bag
7. Hand-quilted Christmas tree skirt
8. Hand-quilted table runner

#### **MACHINE QUILTING—Refer to 2020 OAAS Rules & Regs on Pg 63.**

- The “Best Machine-Quilted Quilt of Fair” will be chosen from Section 10. Quilt is required to be a minimum of 324” measured on the perimeter, and the **complete quilt** must be the work of only **one** individual to qualify. It must have visible machine quilting. It must not be quilted on a long arm machine. The winning quilt will be awarded a Rosette and will be entered in the District OAAS Competition. The 1st place winner at District Level will then proceed to the OAAS Provincial Level Competition. A 2nd place “Best Machine-Quilted Quilt of Fair” will also be chosen, winning a Rosette. **If you wish your quilt to be considered for this award it MUST have an entry tag for “Best Machine-Quilted Quilt” in addition to the regular Class Entry tag.**

**NOTE:** Long-arm quilting refers to any type of quilting done on a machine other than a domestic table top or cabinet sewing machine.

**Prize money: 1st—\$20, 2nd—\$15, 3rd—\$10**

9. Quilt, machine-quilted, pattern named, any technique, minimum total perimeter 324". Made solely by the exhibitor. This is for the OAAS competition (see note above) (SBA, SMA)

**Prize money: 1st—\$8, 2nd—\$6, 3rd—\$4**

10. Quilt, crib or lap, machine-quilted, any quilting technique (SBA, SMA)
11. Christmas tree skirt, machine-quilted (SBA, SMA)
12. Any other machine-quilted article not listed above (ie. cushion, table runner, etc.) (SBA, SMA)

### **QUILTING SPECIALS**

**Prize money: 1st—\$10, 2nd—\$8, 3rd—\$6**

13. My first quilt—made by first time quilter—hand or machine quilted (SMA, SBA)
14. An article of Quilting—must be completely made by exhibitor under the age of 16 years.
15. Any quilted item demonstrating a new quilting idea or technique—please include a brief explanation of how it is made, ie. paper piecing. Could be machine or hand-quilted.
