1. Handmade Birthday gift for a child, any medium, max. size 12” x 12”
2. Robot made from tin cans, max. size 12” x 18”
3. Any article using the Origami technique
4. A handmade toy other than a Teddy bear or doll
5. An article using the quilling technique-not quilting
6. Any occasion front door decoration other than Christmas
7. An article made from a man’s work sock/socks
8. Any item showing off the Tie-Dye technique
9. 3 small articles- all different for a bazaar displayed in a basket
10. Best dressed doll. Set of hand made doll clothes, using any technique, displayed on a doll.
11. Hand made grapevine wreath decorated using the theme “The Colours of Fall”
12. A hand made puppet
13. Using a pre-made stepping stone, create a welcome sign for the garden
14. A small article using leather tooling i.e., wallet
15. Original souvenir made from local materials suitable for sale for tourists
16. A small driftwood craft, max. size 18” x 18”
17. A craft made with 2 different throw away items
18. An article of needlework made on plastic canvas
19. A small article made using the wood burning technique max. size 12” x 18” i.e. ornament, small sign
20. A hostess gift, any occasion, value under \$10

21. Best decorated or functional homemade craft using mason jar/jars and or 2-piece snap lid/lids
22. Adult LEGO – an original designed item made out of LEGO blocks, not a pre-designed kit. Max. size 12” x 18”
23. A craft item that best displays the theme of the fair, “All Colours of Fall”

FINE ARTS & CREATIVE WRITING

24. Creative writing- a written piece by hand or on the computer, 1 page, on “The Colours of Fall” – mounted, could have a decorative border
25. Penmanship- hand written, 8 lines of a favorite Fall poem-mounted, could have a decorative border
26. An original poem, hand written or printed on computer of the Fair theme “The Colours of Fall”
27. A completed page from an adult colouring book using pencil crayon, mounted on Bristol board, may have a border
28. A completed page from an adult colouring book using markers, mounted on Bristol board, may have a border
29. A small pottery or ceramic item- hand painted
30. A painting – oil or acrylic, max. size 18” x 24”, framing is optional, theme “Autumn Splendor”
31. A small painting- water colours, max. size 18” x 24”, framing is optional, theme “Autumn Splendor”
32. Any drawing using black pencil, coloured pencil or pastels, topic of your choice
33. A small article of stained glass not to exceed 12”

34. Christmas- any craft item with a Christmas theme
35. Valentine’s Day- any craft item featuring hearts
36. St. Patrick’s Day- any item to help celebrate St. Patrick’s Day
37. Easter- any craft item with an Easter theme
38. Canada Day- a small craft item to celebrate Canada’s Birthday
39. Thanksgiving- any craft item with a Thanksgiving theme
40. Halloween- any craft item to celebrate Halloween
