7. Small painted pumpkin

Class 39 Crafts - Ages 9-12

2. Pine cone wreath (base can be used)
3. Mason jar candle holder decorated for fall
4. Decoration for door- fall theme
5. Craft made from wooden spoon
6. Painted picture on canvas of a sunset and lake
7. Picture taken by you- fall
8. Decorated apple – any medium

Class 40 Crafts - Ages 13-16

1. Canvas painting fall scene
2. Quilt block 12x 12 from paper or foam core
3. Knitted or crochet item
4. Harvest centerpiece – from nature
5. Duct tape project
6. Stained glass lantern – any medium (lantern can be bought from dollar store)
7. Hand drawn picture of Middleville Fair
8. Something made from deer antler
